Apple Push Notifications (APNs) is a service provided by Apple that allows you to send push notifications to your iOS and macOS devices. It is a part of the Apple Push Notification service (APNs) framework.

Before you can use APNs, you need to create an Apple ID and a Vendor-Signed Certificate (CSR) for your application. The CSR is used to generate a push notification certificate.

1. Create a CSR (Certificate Signing Request)

To create a CSR, you need to use the Cerberus Enterprise Vendor-Signed Certificate Signing Request (CSR) tool. This tool generates a CSR file that you can use to create a push notification certificate.
