- **Report location**: The device reports its location when it enters or exits the geofence.
- **Location mode**: Set to **Enforced** to ensure location services are always on.
- **Share location disabled**: Disables location sharing with other apps.

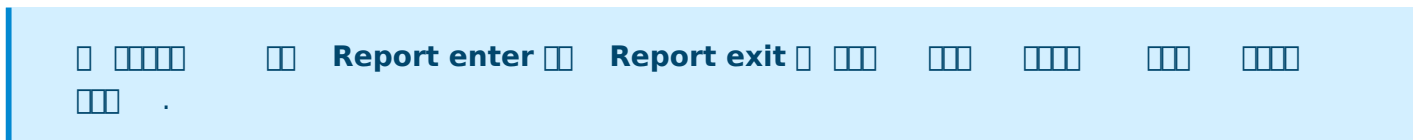

Geofence list (Geofence list)

The geofence list shows all active geofences on the device. You can view up to 10 geofences.

Add geofence: Tap the plus icon to add a new geofence.

- **Name**: The name of the geofence.
- **Color**: The color of the geofence.
- **Radius (m)**: The radius of the geofence, ranging from 100 to 10000 meters.
- **Report enter / Report exit**: Checkboxes to enable or disable reporting when the device enters or exits the geofence.
- **Active**: A checkbox to enable or disable the geofence.



Map editing tools (Map editing tools)

The map editing tools allow you to create and edit geofences on a map. You can tap the map to create a geofence or drag the map to edit an existing one.
